

Remark:

1. Students must meet the graduation credit requirements.
2. This department encourages students to choose a specialization (tourism management or food and beverage management), totaling 18 credits.
3. The department encourages students to choose either practical (courses designed to help students find employment) or academic (courses designed to help students pursue further education and conduct academic research) for a total of 18 credits.
4. Students must meet the department's total graduation credit requirements and comply with the requirements for English proficiency and international study to be eligible for graduation.
5. Students who choose to take practical courses should take at least one off-campus internship elective course.
