Remark :

1. The department encourages students to choose a distinctive field (tourism management or food and beverage management), totaling 18 credits.
2. Students must meet the graduation credit requirements.

4. This department encourages students to choose either practical (courses designed to prepare students for employment and help them find jobs) or academic (courses designed to prepare students for further studies and help them engage in academic research) courses, totaling 18 credits.
5. Students who choose to take practical courses should take at least one off-campus internship elective course.
6. In addition to completing the required total graduation credits within the study period, students must also pass the department's "English Proficiency" graduation qualification test and the "International Study" requirements in order to be eligible for graduation.
